Short term forecast

In the afternoon a few patches of cloud will develop in places but conditions will remain dry and

The overnight period will see clear skies for most. A few patches of cloud might develop in places but it will remain dry.

Tomorrow will start with dry conditions and plenty of sunshine. Patchy cloud will develop as the afternoon progresses but there will be no rain associated with it.

2 to 5 day forecast

A dry and warm start to the day on Thursday. Later in the afternoon a line of potentially heavy showers will move in from the south. A cloudy start to Friday with further showers that might turn heavy. Turning drier in the afternoon with sunny spells possible.
