

SOAP BOX DERBY RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The course starts on the tarmac path in Rushden Hall Park and consists of a downhill section, then a right turn onto a downhill slope on a grass surface towards the finish line.
- All competing karts, drivers and pushers must arrive in the pits **before 6.30 pm** for the judging and scrutinising. The first race will start at **7 pm prompt**.
- There are 3 entry classes: Ages 6 - 11 years, 12 - 16 years, 17 years and over
- Event organisers reserve the right to change the above entry groups depending on the number of participants.
- £25 cash prizes will be awarded for winners in each entry class. There will also be awards for the most innovative/craziest design.
- Certificates will be awarded to all team entries.

Health & Safety

- All drivers must wear a helmet - cycle helmets are acceptable.
- Knee and elbow pads are strongly encouraged. If these are not available, participants are to wear long sleeved tops, long trousers and enclosed shoes. No bare skin on arms and legs.
- **All participants under 18 years must have the event's disclaimer signed by a parent/guardian. Any photographs taken for the benefit of future publicity will be used unless notified not to.**

Kart Design

- The kart size can be no longer than 1000mm wide and 2000mm in length.
- Karts MUST have a solid floor.
- The kart should not exceed 110kg in weight (obviously not including the driver)
- Chassis clearance should be no higher than 30-45cm from the ground.
- All karts must have efficient brakes and steering system.
- All karts must not have more than 2 drivers at any one time. Both drivers must be safely secured inside the kart.
- No nails to be used in the construction of the kart - screws only.
- Each kart must be gravity powered - no motors or engines. Karts must free-wheel with no stored energy or added weights.
- All karts must have 4 wheels, one on each corner.
- Must not have any design element to endanger themselves or the public (I.e. No sharp metal objects, mirrors or glass)
- All karts will be scrutinised in the pits at 6.30pm to check these safety requirements are met. Judging for the most innovative/craziest design will take place at this time.

- 5 crew members per Team.
- There can be a maximum of 2 drivers per team.
- There can be a maximum of 1 pusher in each race.
- No team will be allowed to compete under the influence of drugs and alcohol.
- Teams must follow the instructions of the race organisers and marshals.
- All members of a team must sign a declaration absolving the organisers from any liability and responsibility during scrutiny.
- **All under 18s must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or guardian, who has signed the permission form AT ALL TIMES.**
- One kart can be used by more than one team, but only one prize will be given to the innovative/craziest design category.
- All teams must return their named driver form **NO LATER THAN 4.30 PM ON FRIDAY 8 JUNE** for certification purposes.

THE ORGANISERS' DECISION IS FINAL**

FREE ENTRY

The organisers reserve the right to disqualify any or all members of teams that demonstrate inappropriate conduct.

All kart designs must be family appropriate and must be removed at the end of the event.

The purpose of the event is to have FUN, but safety of the teams, supporters and spectators is paramount throughout the evening, and accordingly the organisers reserve the right to amend these rules or go above and beyond their guidance.
